

MVRC Field Rules

1. All people flying at the MVRC field will have current Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) membership and be either a member of MVRC or an authorized guest of a Member. Exceptions are allowed if participating in the AMA Introductory Pilot Program.
2. Guests with Current AMA cards may fly only two times per calendar year. Otherwise nonmembers must obtain a permit from park offices in Greensburg to fly. A fee may be required.
3. Fliers will obey all AMA and MVRC safety rules. Know and follow the AMA safety code before flying.
4. Fliers will use the frequency control board by placing their MVRC card (or a copy) on the pin associated with their transmitter frequency before turning on the transmitter. If sharing a frequency, inactive transmitter(s) will be placed in impound area while awaiting their turn to fly.
5. Fliers with Spectrum Transmitters should place MVRC card in pin board in appropriate place.
6. If the Amateur Band is to be used, have the FCC license with you.
7. Remain in active pilot stand while flying.
8. Announce vocally "takeoffs", "landings", and "on the field".
9. Unless hand launching, take off from and land on the runway. Do not take off from the pits or behind other pilots.
10. Never over-fly spectators or cars.
11. Never fly over main park, ball fields, or private homes.
12. Avoid flying low over the marina.
13. Consumption of alcohol prior to and/or during flying is not permitted.
14. Be aware, in all cases, piloted aircraft *MUST* be avoided. Spotter *should* be encouraged, especially for beginners. Flying alone is not advised because of low flying piloted aircraft. Flying is limited to 500 feet altitude.
15. Be courteous! Do not allow propeller blast to disturb other planes or pilots
16. And remember, keep the field clean, as if it is your home (Some of us spend more time at the field than at home).
